

Can You Help Us Help Others?

In 1998, Joseph's Coat ministry was founded by one courageous woman named Joanne to help Central Ohio families in need. The first ministry was housed in a two-car garage and offered clothing to families. The ministry was supported by volunteers from area churches.

Joseph's Coat later expanded to include furniture and household goods to provide resources to families transitioning from homelessness to permanent housing. In 2012, Joseph's Coat became a non-profit corporation. Today, Joseph's Coat partners with a number of churches to serve individuals and families in Central Ohio struggling to achieve stability and self-sufficiency.

This year, Joseph's Coat has experienced 1296 visits by families who've shopped for 39,526 clothing and household items. An additional 224 families have received 1,856 furniture items. Of that furniture number, 355 mattresses, box springs and bed sets were provided at no cost, and with the exception of furniture, requiring no agency or caseworker referrals.

Each year, Joseph's Coat holds a Fall silent auction to raise money to support our operations and mission. Due to Covid, the 2020 and 2021 auctions have been cancelled. In their place, we are holding an online auction. The auction will run for 10 days from 11/4 to 11/14.

Can you help us continue our efforts to help others? We are currently looking for donated items to include in the auction. (Due to liability concerns, we cannot accept alcohol donations).
